


# Craft Instructions




## Chinese Dragon Paper Chain Craft

### Instructions:

Important information: When folding the Chinese Dragon Paper Chain Craft these folds and guides are important to know – please insert pictures of the hill fold and valley fold.



### Step 1. Folding the 'Dragon Head'



- Cut along the outside solid black line for the dragonhead and horns.
- Following the fold guidelines – fold along the lines of the dragonhead. Hint: make your folds sharp.
- Glue tabs 1 and 2 to begin shaping the face.
- Glue tabs 3 and 4 to shape the back of the head.
- Glue tabs 5 and 6 to shape the snout. The bottom of the snout in to match up and attach in line with the bottom of the tab.
- Glue the horns to matching tab 7 and set the head aside.

### Step 2. Form the Paper Chain



- Cut out the paper chains following the solid black line.
- Begin to form the chain starting at chain number 10 and following the numbers in order to number 16. It's important to follow this order.
- The chain links are created by pasting the tab number to the base of the strip forming a circle and then linking the circles together.



## Craft Instructions

### Step 3. Form the Dragon

- Glue the head of the dragon to tabs 8 and 9 to the first link number 10.
- Cut along the solid black line of the tail.
- Fold along the lines to form the tail.
- Glue the tail to the tabs 17 and 18 on last link number 16.



Your complete dragon will look like this:
