What materials can we recycle at home?   | Make a junk model out of different recycling materials.  | Make a poster about different materials. Discuss the properties of materials. For example: hard, soft, transparent, translucent or opaque.                                 |
| <b>History</b><br><br>Who instigated the plot? | Create a poster all about bonfire night and fire safety.   | Research The Gunpowder Plot.   | Create your own firework poster using paints or any materials you find in your house.  |
| <b>ART</b><br><br>Focused Artist Megan Coyle  | Find out some facts about Megan Coyle on the internet.   | Experiment making your own collage using different materials.  | Use old cut up magazines, comics picture cards or newspapers to make a collage of an animal.   |
| <b>PSHE</b><br><br>Celebrating differences    | Identify the different celebrations and festivals people celebrate this term.  | Make a poster about your family and what things you like to do together.   | Make a list of activities that promote turn-taking. E.g., playing family board games together.   |
