A wonderful Harry Potter cupboard has been kindly donated to the school by a member of the PTA, and will be located in the school library area. This cupboard has been transformed to store a selection of books. Every Wednesday afternoon, two of our amazing PTA reading volunteers will collect children, across the school, and support them in swapping their book with another in the Book Swap Shop.

How can your child take part?

If you have a book that your child has read and doesn't want anymore, and it is still in good condition with all the pages intact, your child can bring the book to school on a Wednesday. In the afternoon, your child will be taken to the library area to visit the Book Swap Shop cupboard. There, they can swap their old, unwanted book for a book of their choice. Your child will take their new book home with them at the end of the day. They can either keep this book at home or swap it again when they are ready.
