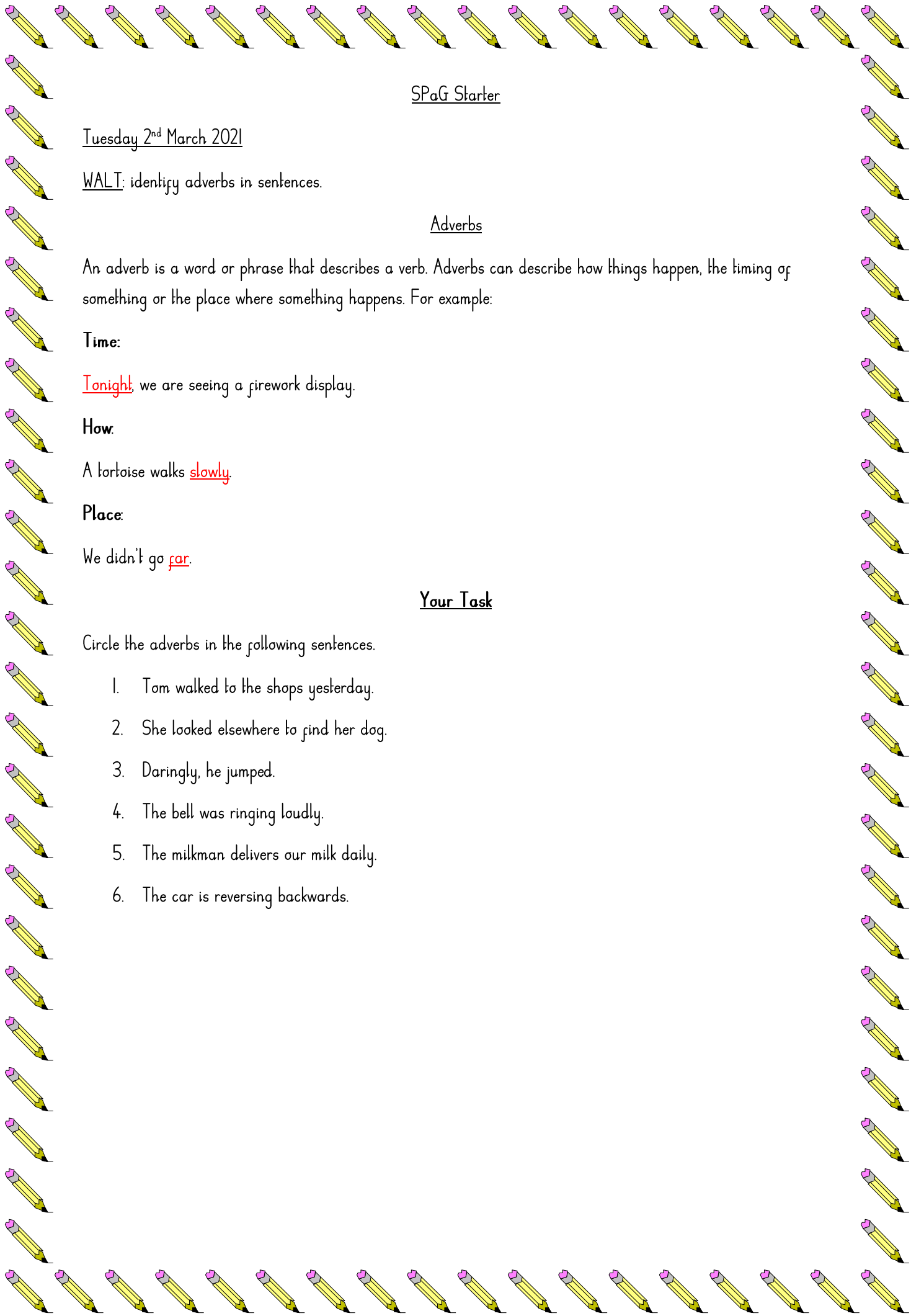

An adverb is a word or phrase that describes a verb. Adverbs can describe how things happen, the timing of something or the place where something happens. For example:

Time:

How:

A tortoise walks slowly.
