Non-chronological report

WALT: use a sentence of three.

In today's lesson we will be using a sentence of three. This is 3 short sentences that could link together.

For example:

She ran into the room. She picked up the book. She left the room in a hurry.

This sounds very repetitive so we put it into 1 sentence:

She ran into the room, picked up the book and left the room in a hurry.

You can make this even better by adding in an adverb to describe how the action is completed:

She ran into the room, hastily picked up the book and sped back out again in a hurry.

Activity 1 * (must do): Put the sentences together to create a basic sentence of three.

Activity 2 ** (challenge): rewrite the sentences of three and improve them with an adverb.

I walked home. I went in the house. I told my dad.

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The Iron man lifted his iron foot. He stepped in to the air. He fell over.

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The Iron man ate some tractors. He went home. He got stuck.

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I ran back home. I told my dad. I told the other farmers.

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I ran as fast as I could. I tripped over. I got into my house.

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The Iron man walked past our house. He ate our car. He is now heading to the village hall.

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We got ready. We ran into the forest. We waited forever.

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My father found out. He made a trap. The iron man fell in to the pit.
