Actions as a result of feedback:

EYFS:

- Termly progress summaries to be reviewed by EYFS Lead.
- Workshops have now been resumed.
- School staff are available at the end of the school day to speak to parents / carers, once their pupils have been dismissed.

KSI:

All religious festivals are recognised through whole school assemblies and weekly RE lessons. Activities for Eid are part of the annual planning cycle along with other religious celebrations.

KS2:

- Improving playground activities are currently being discussed by the School Council this term.
- Homework is now marked by all class teachers. Most English and maths tasks are differentiated.
- Due to the low uptake, wraparound care plans have been put on hold.
- Newsletters and most letters are now shared via text message / email. Please see staff in the main reception office if you do not receive this form of communication.
- Every child should receive maths / English / phonics (EYFS / KSI) / reading comprehension (KS2) / spelling and a homework grid for homework activities. Please speak to your child's class leacher if your child is not receiving this range of homework.
