Introduct	Words ending in 'le' are usually pronounced /ul/ following a consonant. Can the children think of any words that end in 'le'? This is the most common spelling of this sound at the end of words.				
Main Teaching Activity	Get the children to say the words and copy them down on to their whiteboard. Which words have an /ul/ sound and which have a /l/ sound? Compare the difference between the grapheme 'le' and the /l/ sound when it is in different positions in a word.				
Independ	Get the children to look at the images and write the spelling for each word, remind children that this week's spellings have the 'le' ending.  Share the spellings as a class.
