

Introduction	Introduce the digraph sounds ay and oy to the class. These sounds are often found at the end of words.
Main Teaching Activity	Ask the children to draw a line down their whiteboards and put 'toy' at the top of one side and 'say' at the top of the other side. Get them to work in pairs to see how many rhyming words they can add (with the same spelling pattern) to each side. Share the results and discuss and misconceptions or incorrectly spelled words.
Independent Activity	Children to work in pairs to practise writing the words, one child picks a word and their partner writes it on the whiteboard. The first child checks the word and then they switch roles.


