Hindu Prayer

A mantra is a motivating chant. The Gayatri mantra is believed to be Hinduism's most representative prayer. Many Hindus recite it on a daily basis.

Jewish Prayer

Some Jewish people choose to pray three times a day: morning, afternoon and evening. The Jewish prayer book is called a siddur.

Islamic Prayer

Salat is the obligatory Muslim prayers, performed five times each day by some Muslims. Muslims try to make sure that they are in the right frame of mind before they pray; they put aside all every day cares and thoughts so that they can concentrate exclusively on God.
