<u>Week 4</u>

<u>WALT:</u> recognise different religious buildings.

Synagogue - The synagogue is the Jewish place of worship, but is also used as a place to study, and often as a community centre as well. On the outside of the building there is a Star of David.



Mosque - The mosque is the traditional Muslim place of worship. The four main features that most mosques have are a mihrab (niche), minaret (tower), qubba (dome) and sahn (courtyard).



Mandir — A Hindu temple is called a mandir. It is a sacred place for Hindu worship. Traditionally, the outside walls of a mandir are usually decorated with sculptured representations of Gods. At the heart of the building is the shrine room.
