carefully counting all.

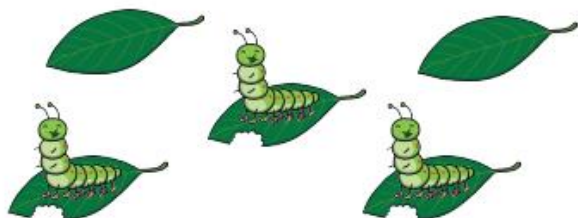
Jill sat her toys on 2 shelves. How many toys does she have altogether?

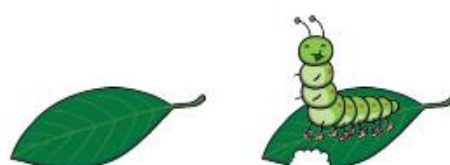
Challenge: children to write their own addition/subtraction number sentences. We would love to see these added to your 'Evidence Me' profiles.

Can you count how many leaves there are altogether?



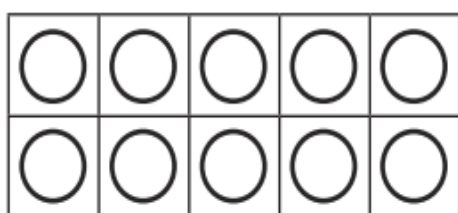
If the caterpillars eat 3 leaves, how many leaves will be left?
