RSE Parent Consultation

You may have heard in the news that the Government have made Relationship and Health Education statutory for all primary schools. To ensure that we promote the personal wellbeing and development of all pupils, whilst meeting new statutory requirements, we have purchased a Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) Education programme of work called 'Jigsaw'.

Jigsaw brings together PSHE, the compulsory section, Relationships and Health Education, emotional literacy, mindfulness, social skills and spiritual development. It is designed as a whole school approach, with all year groups working on the same theme at the same time at the appropriate level. There are six half-term units of work, entitled 'puzzles' and each year group are taught one lesson per week.

Jigsaw has two main aims for the children:

- To build their capacity for learning; and
- To equip them for life.

To introduce parents to the proposed changes and ensure everyone is well informed of our PSHE curriculum, we would like to invite you to read the following key documents, (These have been attached for your reference):
