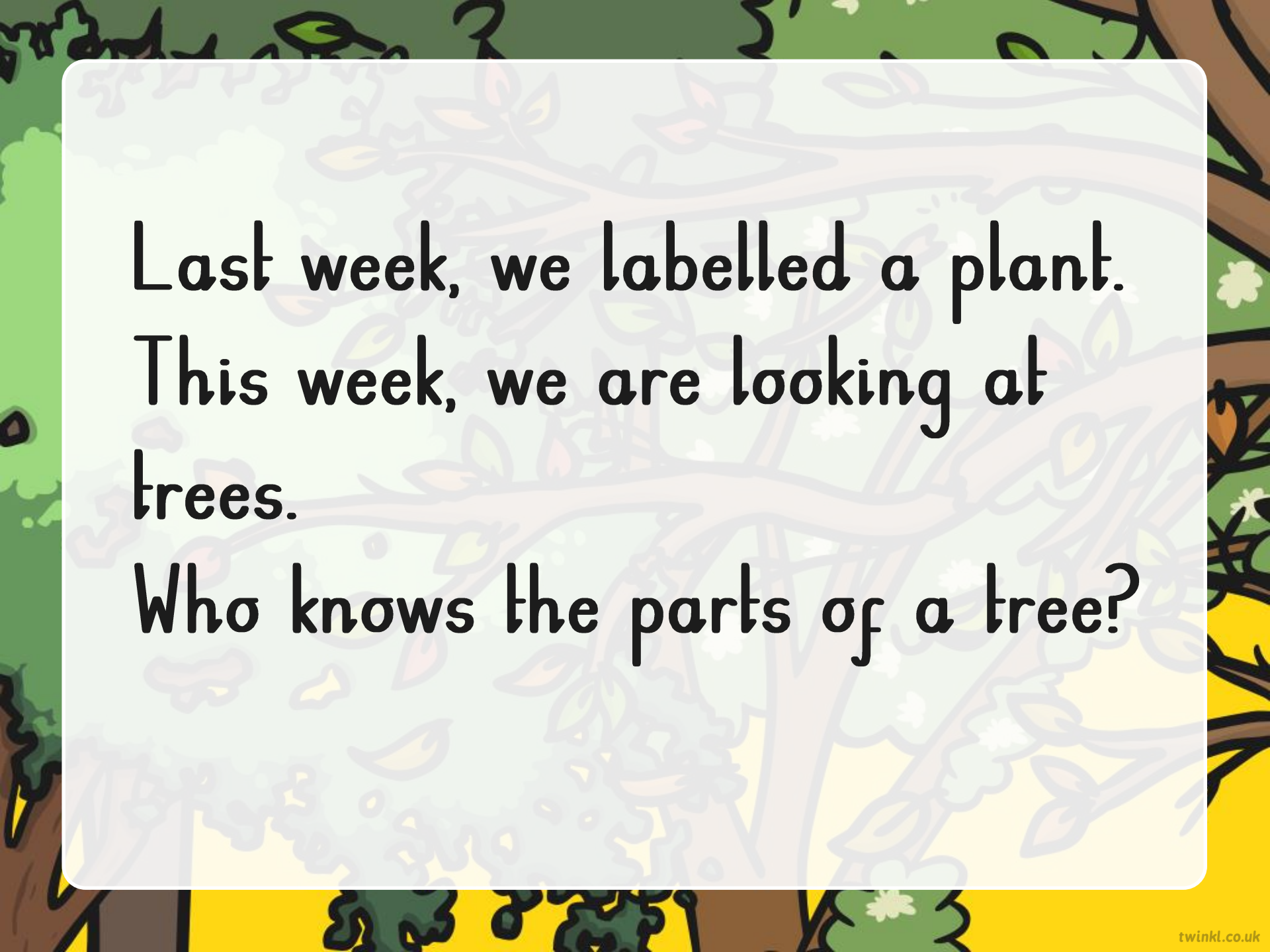
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Terrific Trees

This week, we are looking at
trees.

Who knows the parts of a tree?

Crown

At the top of the tree and is made up of leaves and branches

Leaves

gather water and nutrients for the tree

Trunk

Supports the whole tree

Bark

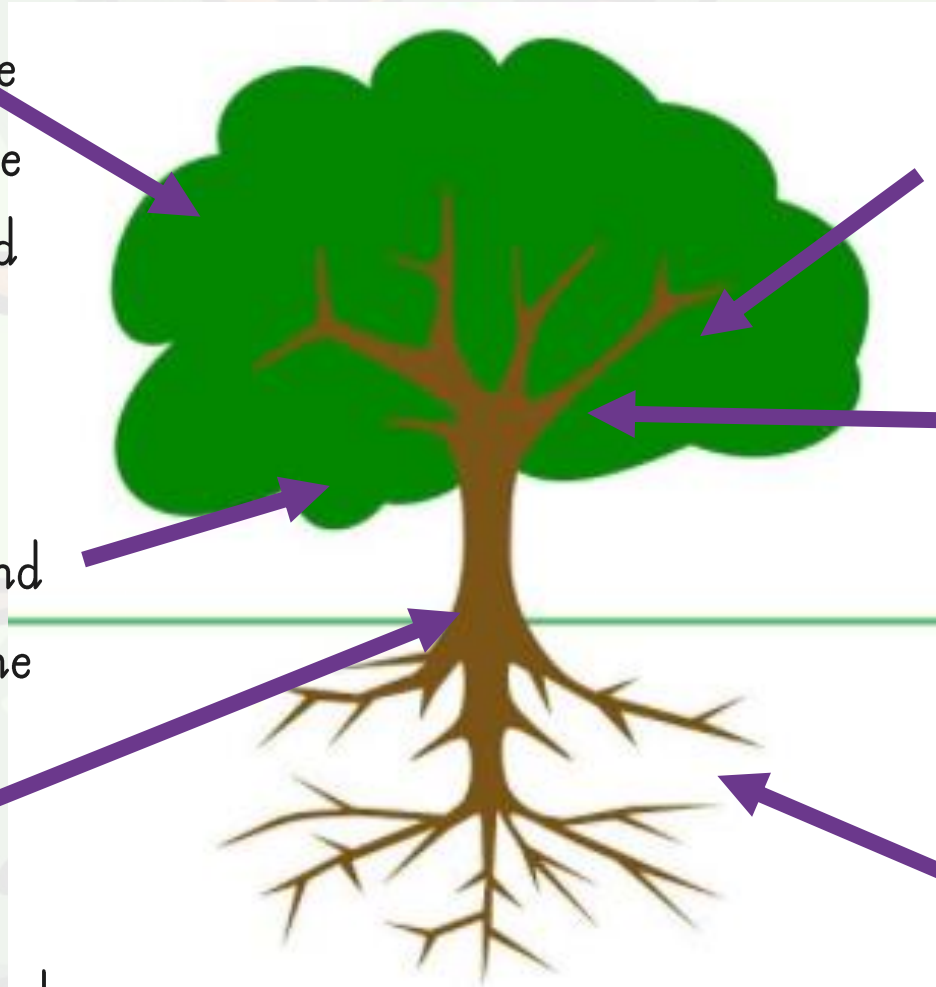
The outer layer of the trunk

Branches

They hold the leaves securely

Roots

They gather water and nutrients to help the tree grow
