You must do all three boxes every week: Reading, maths and spelling

Reading  Read for approximately 10 minutes every day. You may read books from home, school or the school website (virtual library virtual-library-final-draft.pdf (primarysite-prod-sorted.s3.amazonaws.com)). You can also read magazines, newspapers, packaging, computer information etc. Fill in you reading diary every time that you read.	Maths  Complete the set maths homework. Sometimes your homework will be set using the Mathletics app. Practise your times tables using your TT-Rockstars log in. Try to do approximately 5 minutes every day.	Spellings  Complete the spelling homework that has been set. Try to practise a little bit every night. Spelling activities: Use your spelling shed log in to practise and revisit all of your previous spellings.
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Project based homework The suggested ideas below are linked to the work that you will be covering in class this half term. You can choose a **minimum** of 3 projects. However, if you would like to, or have time, you can do as many or more if you like. Your work can be presented in many different ways, such as through art, presentations to the class or on the computer, 3D models, written work etc. Be creative and have fun learning!

Science  Light	Draw a shadow picture. Use a torch to cast a shadow, draw around it and label it.	Research the scientist Thomas Edison.	Draw and label a light source. Explore how the light travels from this light source.	Write a list of materials that are transparent, translucent and opaque around your home.	Investigation- Investigate how shadows get bigger	Explore – How many light sources are in your house?
Geography  Mountains and rivers.	Research the River Severn and show your learning in your own way.	Create a piece of art with a mountain focus.	Make a model of the water cycle.	Create a word search with key words about a river.	Research a mountain range and show your learning in your own way.	Create a model of a mountain range.
Art  Sketching/Drawing	Sketch an object such as a tree, piece of fruit, flower, landscape or building etc.	Draw what you can see out of your window.	See how many different shades you can make with your pencil (try pressing lighter or harder)	Draw a building and note the different textures and lines.	Research the artist Lowry and create a fact file.	Research the artist David Hockney and create a fact file about his work.

List 5 people that can help you achieve your goals/dreams on each finger.	Draw a medal and write down 5 achievements that you are proud of.	Create a poster about how you can help your friends achieve their goals and dreams.
