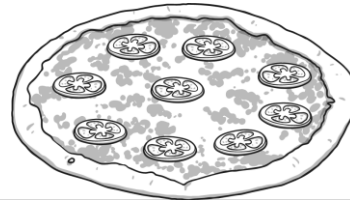


Using Apostrophes to Show Possession

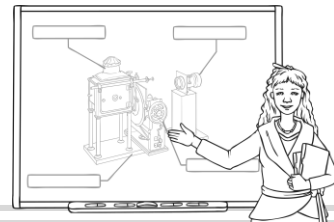

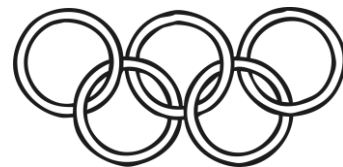
