I zoom up into the night.

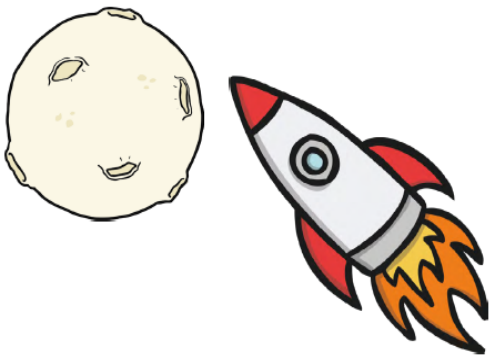
The stars are my light.
