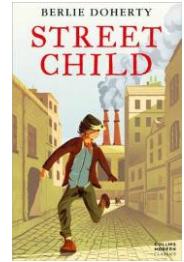

WALT: edit and improve our work.

Task one



You should now have completed the first draft of your story. In today's lesson, we are going to be trying to edit and improve our work. To do this we can look for and add in the following things:

- Trying to up level vocabulary (for example: changing "run" to "sprint")
- Proofreading your work to check that it makes sense
- Changing incorrect spellings

You can do this to small sections of your work or you could rewrite paragraphs if you feel that you can improve it.

Here are some examples of how I have improved my work:

Original sentence:

That's what the policeman said: "Take 'em to the workhouse."

Improved sentence:

That's what the **intimidating** policeman **demanding in an angry voice**: "Take 'em to the workhouse."

Original sentence:

A group of boys were shouting and fighting which distracted the policeman from Jim.

Improved sentence:

A group of **rough looking** boys were shouting and fighting **like a pack of wild animals**, which distracted the **horrifying** policeman from Jim.
