WALT: write our fable ending and edit.

In today's lesson you will be writing your fable ending. Make sure you read your plan to see what needs to be described. You need to ensure there is a moral in your fable ending that teaches the reader a lesson.

Some potential morals may include:

- Practice makes perfect
- If you see someone in need, help them out
- Don't change to follow a crowd
- Treat others how you wish to be treated.
- Nobody likes a show off.

Once you have finished your fable ending you need to look at your whole story.

Now it is time to edit your work.

1 - Up level your words, choosing powerful vocabulary. For example, choose yelled instead of said.

2 - Check for spellings and punctuation errors.
