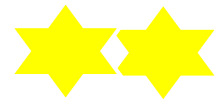
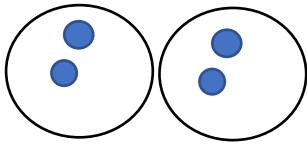


WALT: use arrays to divide numbers by more than 3

The number 2 tells us how many circles we need. The 4 is how many we need to share equally. Then count the dots in ONE circle.
