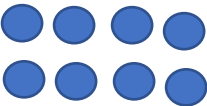


WALT: create multiplication sums using arrays.



Look at the pictures, count how many columns and rows there are. This will give the 2 numbers for the start of your multiplication sum. Then count them all for the answer.

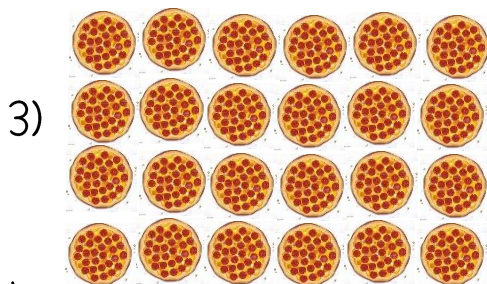
EG  $4 \times 2 = 8$



$$3 \times 3 = 9$$



$$5 \times 3 = 15$$



$$6 \times 4 = 24$$



$$6 \times 5 = 30$$
