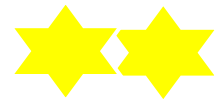
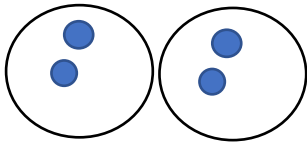


WALT: use arrays to divide numbers by more than 3



Watch the video on the school website to see how we can use arrays to divide by 2 and 3. $4 \div 2 =$

The number 2 tells us how many circles we need. The 4 is how many we need to share equally. Then count the dots in ONE circle.



1) $8 \div 4 = 2$

2) $10 \div 5 = 2$

3) $12 \div 4 = 3$

4) $12 \div 6 = 2$

A large, empty rectangular box intended for drawing an array to solve the division problem $12 \div 6 = 2$.
