Monkey is funny, playful and mischievous. Giraffe is lonely, sad and quiet.
Build up	• This is where we find out a little bit more about the characters and the situation they are in.	Both kangaroo and porpoise have babies. When they go hunting, the other character looks after the baby for them. When porpoise hunts, she takes a long time and her baby starts to cry.	Monkey and giraffe are next door neighbours. When one of them goes shopping, the other one guards the water hole in-between their houses. When giraffe goes to drink from the watering hole, she gets her neck stuck in the fence.

Problem	 What goes wrong for our characters? Why are they arguing? 	When porpoise gets back from hunting, kangaroo refuses to give her baby back. This is because the porpoises' baby is much prettier than kangaroo's baby.	When the monkey gets back from shopping, he sees the giraffe stuck in the fence. This is because she put her head through the fence and not over.
Resolution	How do they solve the problem?	The kangaroo and the porpoise fight. The porpoise gets hit on the head. The kangaroo's arms are broken so she hops off with the porpoises' baby in her pouch. The kangaroo baby gets thrown into a tree.	The monkey tries to help giraffe get unstuck. As he pulls the giraffes head, his arms start to stretch and the giraffes neck becomes longer.
Ending	 What happens to our characters at the end of the story? How does the ending link back to the start? 	The porpoise now lives in the sea and spurts water out of her head. The kangaroo's arms are really short so they carry their babies in a pouch.	The monkey The giraffe
