Fable

WALT: write our fable opening using the rule of 3 and the fable build-up.

In today's lesson you will be writing your fable opening and build up. Make sure you read your plan to see what needs to be described. You need to ensure that you put your title at the top and use the rule of 3 to describe both the main characters like they did in our original fable.

E.g.

The Elephant is wise, old and friendly to all of the other creatures in the jungle. Whereas, the Zebra is selfish, fake and only cares about herself.

In my example I have created a clear difference between the two characters and making the reader aware of the characters personalities.

Try and include high quality language in your work. Remember to use a dictionary or google alternative words to use powerful vocabulary. You know how to up level year 3!
