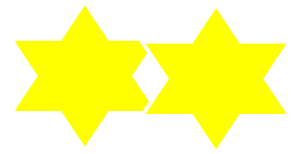
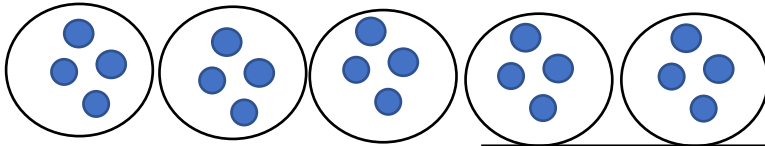


WALT: use arrays to multiply numbers by more than 3.



Watch the video on the school website to see how we can use arrays to multiply numbers. EG $5 \times 4 =$

The number 5 tells us how many circles we need. The 4 is how many dots in each circle. Then count them up.



1) $6 \times 5 = 30$

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2) $7 \times 6 = 42$

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3) $9 \times 5 = 45$

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4) $8 \times 4 = 32$

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
