You Will Need:

- a box

- a blanket

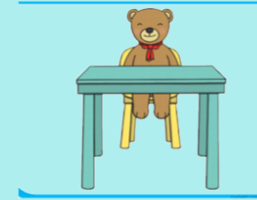
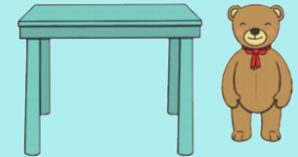
What to Do:

1. First, make a small hole in the box and push the string through.
2. Then, tie the string in a knot and place the box outside.
3. After, place the fresh crunchy carrot underneath the box.
4. Lastly, pull the string hard to knock the box down onto the rabbit and scoop the rabbit in the blanket
