

Monday 11th January 2021

3 stars: Read the story. Can you identify all the features of an opening and any other grammar in the story?

Is there an opening sentence? Is story language used? (Once upon a time, happily ever after etc) Are the characters introduced? Is the setting explained? Is there a build-up that makes you want to read on? Are there any adjectives? Can you find any conjunctions (and, so, because)? How many question marks are there?

Tuesday 12th January 2021

2 stars: Read 'The Three Little Rabbits' story. Can you make any actions for the words?

3 stars: Using the text map example create your own text map for the story. Use your new text map to retell the story.

Wednesday 13th January 2021

Discuss the story. What do we know so far about the characters? What is happening? Why did their mother tell them to leave home? What could happen in the rest of the story? Then try to answer the reading comprehension questions.

1 star: answer questions 1-3

2 stars: answer questions 1-6

3 stars: answer questions 1-10 in full sentences. For example:

Q1- Where did the three little pigs live? The three little pigs lived_____

Thursday 14th January 2021

Read the story using your story map. Can you remember the actions from Tuesday?

Read the story a second time, but don't pause at the full stops. What is different? Why do we have full stops?

1 star: underline all of the full stops.

2 stars: edit the text by putting the full stops in the correct place.

3 stars: edit the text by putting the full stops in the correct place and the capital letters.

Friday 15th January 2021

What are question marks? When do we use question marks? (We use a question mark when we want to know the answer to something) Are there any question marks in our modelled text?

I want you to think of some questions that you would like to ask the three little rabbits or their mother. Here are some examples: Where did they go? Did they see their mother again? Did they live happily ever after? How long did they go away for? Did they have a family? Did they live together? Did they have to move house? Did they stay close to their mother? Did they make any friends? Did they make any enemies?

1 star: write down 1 questions

2 stars: write down 3 questions

3 stars: write down as many questions as possible
