Read the sums and represent both numbers using your dots for ones and rods for tens. Count all your tens and dots together to find your answer.	Look at the subtraction sum and represent the first number with your dots and rods. Using the amount of the second number, cross out the dots and rods you have drawn. Count what is left.	For arithmetic today you will be adding and subtracting 3 numbers together instead of 2. Use your dots and rods to help you.
