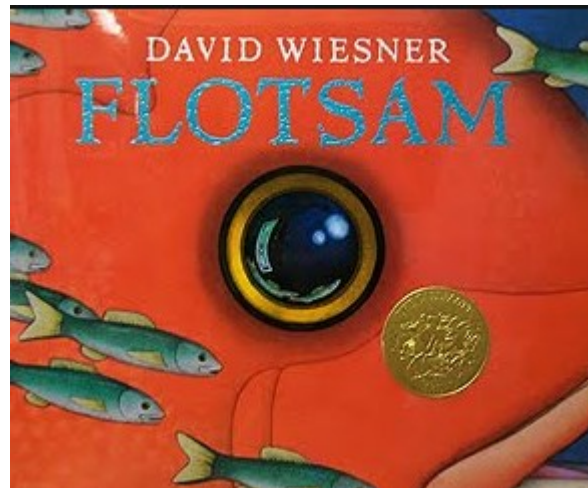

Create a sea themed snack using healthy food which you love to eat.



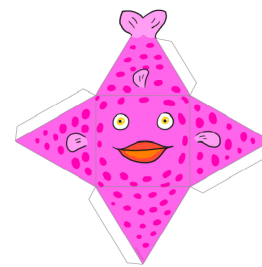
Task 2— Recycled Arts and Craft

Task 3— Maths
