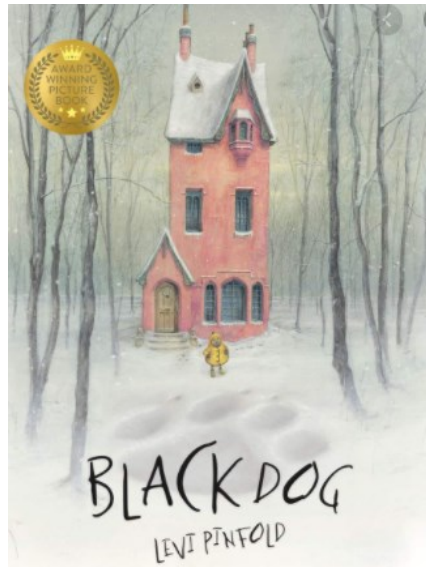

Create a dog shaped snack using healthy food which you love to eat.



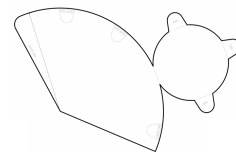
Task 2—Art

Use the net template for a cone to create all of the different characters from the story. Draw their faces onto the circular section and then create the cone shape for all of the family.



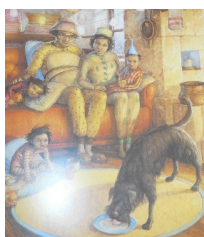
Task 4—Writing

Look at the pictures and think about what the Black Dog might be thinking as he visits the different places in the story. Create some captions, speech and thought bubbles.



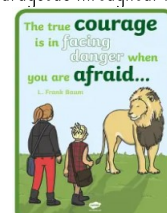
Task 5—Drawing

Create a family portrait for the Hope family with the Black Dog included as a new member of their family.



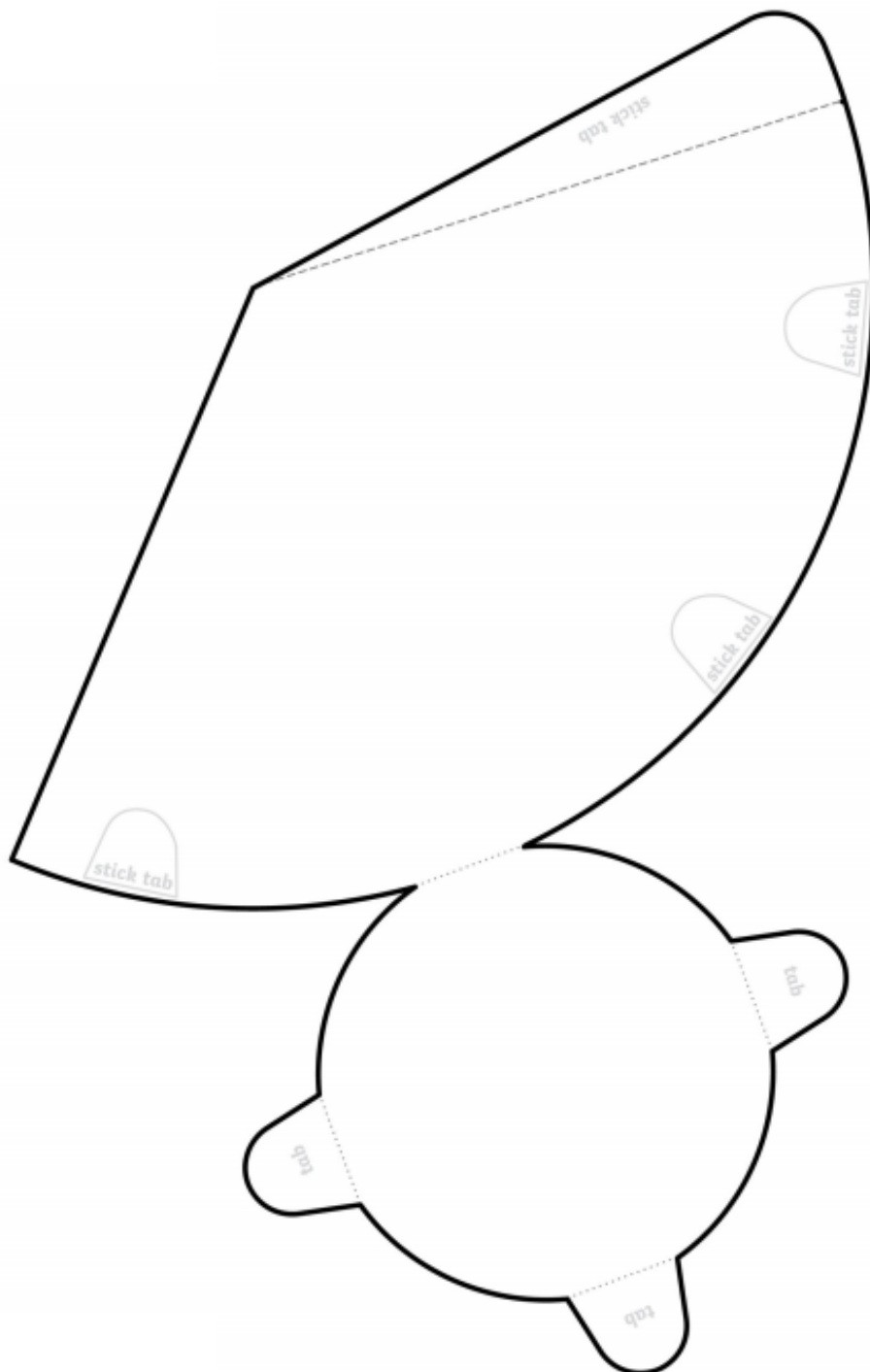
Task 6—PSHE

The story teaches us a very valuable lesson of being courageous to overcome things that may seem frightening at first. See if you can create a poster which includes this quote about being courageous throughout life.



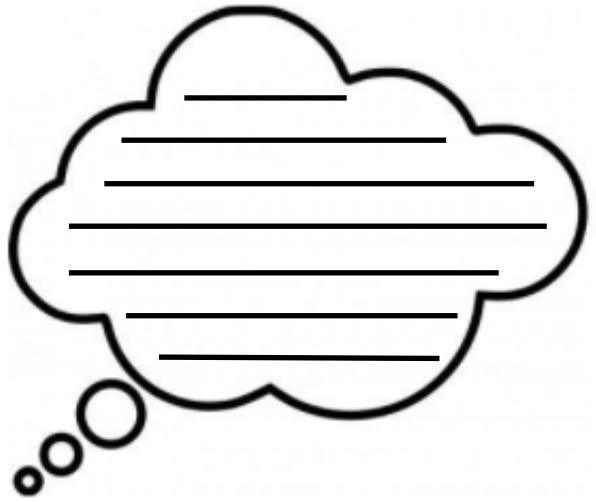
Maths

Draw their faces on the circular section and then create each character by creating a cone using the net.



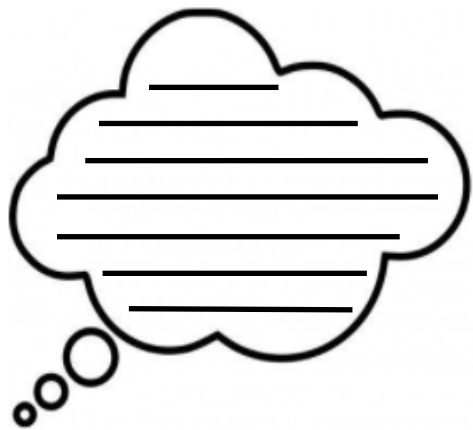
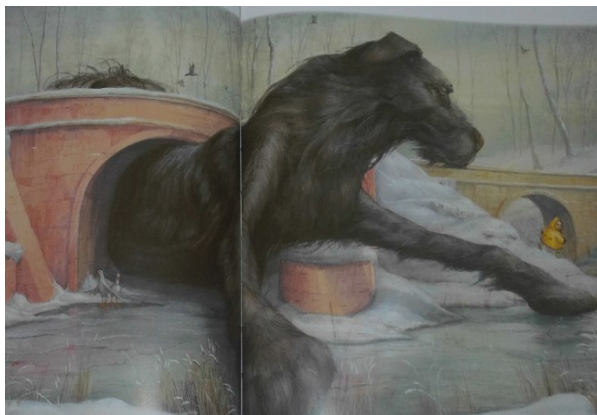

Complete the thought bubbles for each picture.



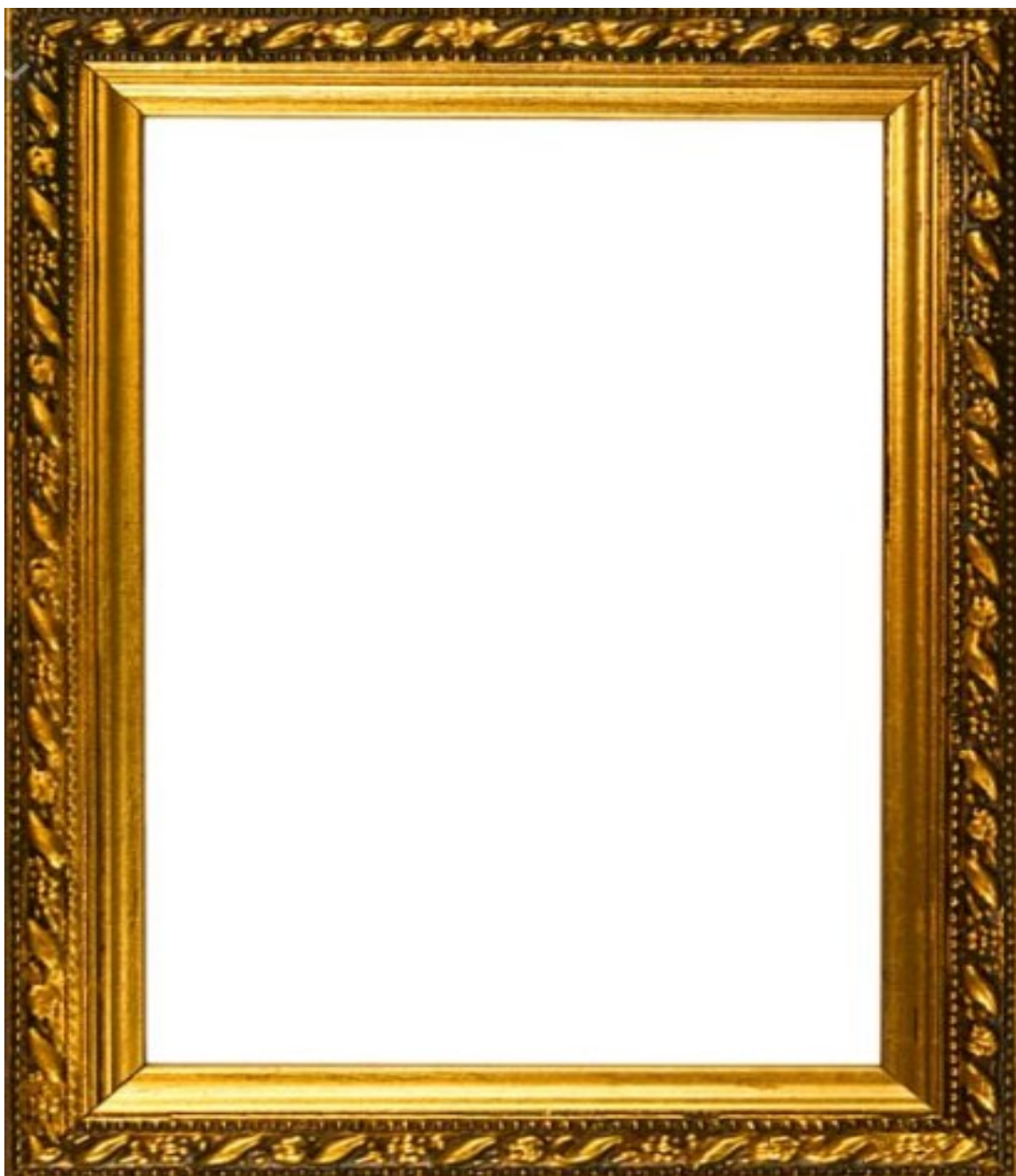
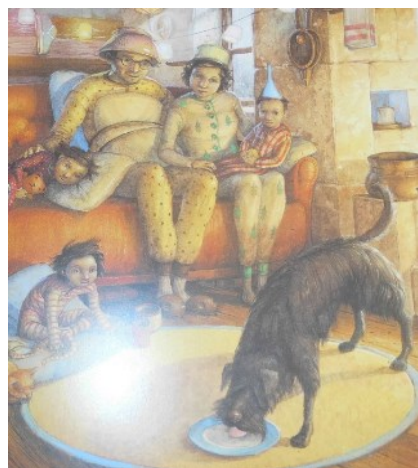
