

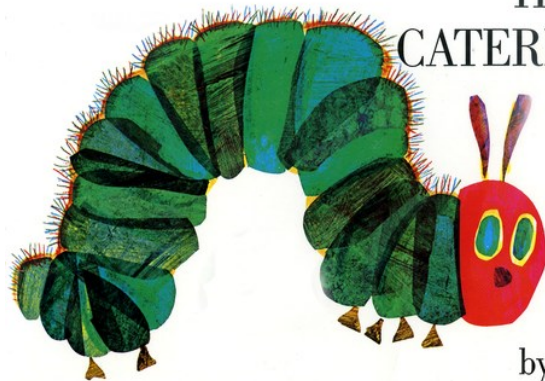

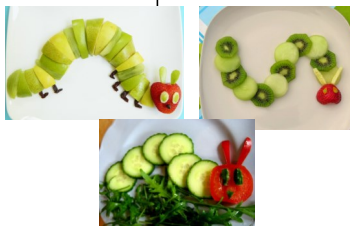

Help an adult to create your very own hungry caterpillar! Use fruit and vegetables to make a healthy caterpillar shaped snack!



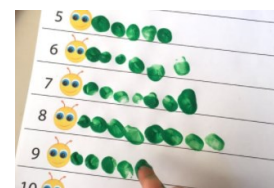
Task 2—Arts and Craft
