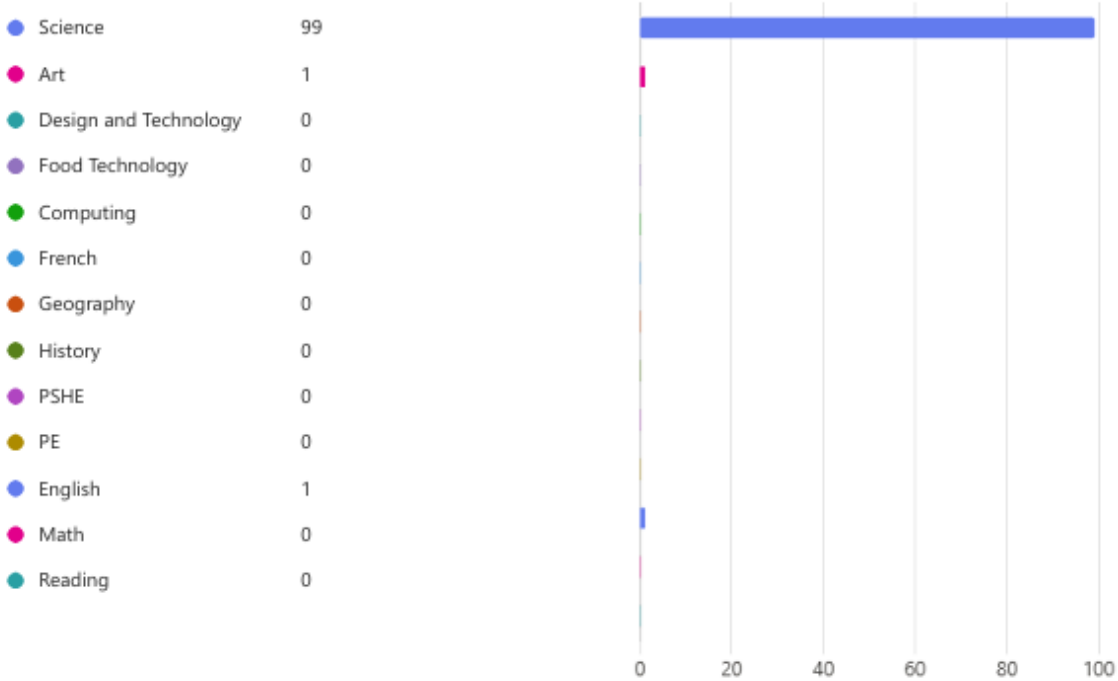

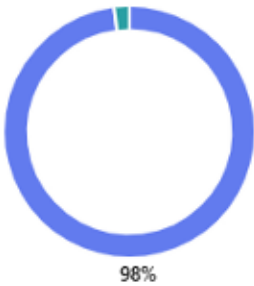

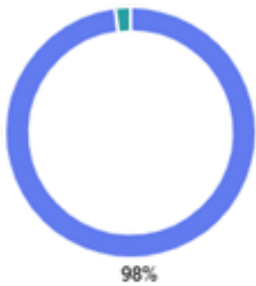
3. Did you find the workshop useful? (0 point)

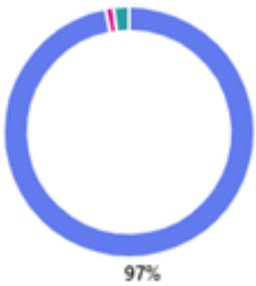
4. Do you think your child was motivated/enjoyed having you there? (0 point)

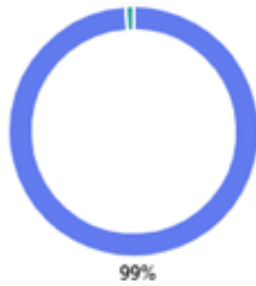
5. Do you now have a better understanding of an element of the curriculum at Reddal Hill? (0 point)

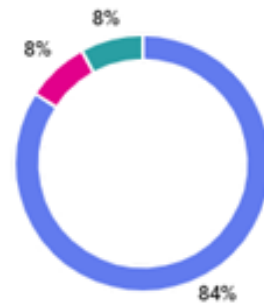
6. Did you enjoy having the opportunity to share an activity with your child? (0 point)

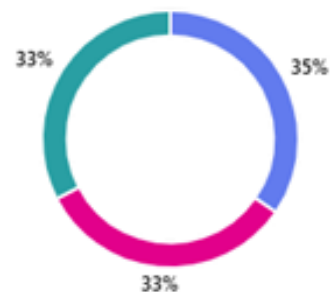
