<p style="text-align: center;">Actions as a result of feedback:</p> <p>EYFS / The NEST:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At school, we keep parents informed of their child's progress in several ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ongoing teacher feedback: Teachers monitor pupils' learning closely and will contact parents if there are any concerns or notable successes that we feel would be helpful for you to know. ○ Parents/ carers' evening meetings: These meetings provide an opportunity to discuss your child's strengths, current attainment and the next steps they are working towards. We share information about how pupils are progressing academically and personally, including areas where they are thriving and those that may benefit from further focus. ○ At the end of each academic year, parents are provided with a report summarising their child's progress for the academic year. 	

- Parents of pupils with SEND receive the same regular feedback provided to all families; however, we also offer additional, personalised communication to ensure they are fully informed about their child's progress. This includes more frequent updates, opportunities for targeted discussions, and termly reviews of All About Me documents that outline specific support strategies and next steps. Pupils with EHCPs meet at least annually with the Assistant Headteacher for Inclusion to discuss the progress made towards personal outcomes, and identify any adaptations required to provision.

- Time-management is a skill that develops over time, and we're committed to helping pupils build it. We'll continue reinforcing routines in class, and we would be happy to share strategies you can use at home so we're supporting your child together. Please let your child's class teacher know if there are particular challenges you've noticed.
- We understand how important it is for families to receive information clearly and consistently. ClassDojo and Arbor each play a different role in how we keep you updated, and both are important for making sure you receive the right type of information. ClassDojo is used for day-to-day class updates, celebrations, and quick messages, while Arbor is our formal system for attendance, reports, and whole-school information. Using both allows us to communicate efficiently and ensure nothing is missed. We will continue to make sure our messages are clear about where information will be shared, and we appreciate you raising this so we can keep communication as smooth as possible.
