You must do four boxes every week: Reading, Maths, English and Spelling

Reading  Read for approximately 10 minutes every day. You may read books from home, school or the school website (virtual library virtual-library-final-draft.pdf (primariesite-prod-sorted.s3.amazonaws.com)). You can also read magazines, newspapers, packaging, computer information etc. Fill in your reading record every time that you read.	Maths  Complete the set maths homework each week. Practise your times tables using your TT-Rockstars log in. Try to do approximately 5 minutes every day. Your passwords can be found at the back of your reading records.	English  You will also have a piece of reading comprehension or SPaG homework to complete each week. This will be linked to our learning that we have done throughout the week.	Spellings  Complete the spelling homework that has been set on Spelling Shed. Try to practise a little bit every night. Spelling activities: Use your spelling shed log in to practise and revisit all of your previous spellings. Remember to use Mastery Zone as well.
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Project-Based Homework: The suggested ideas below are linked to the work that you will be covering in class this half term. You can choose a **minimum** of three projects to complete during the half term. However, if you would like to, or have time to, you can do as many as you like. Your work can be presented in many different ways, such as: through art, presentations to the class, on the computer, 3D models or written work etc.

Write five questions and answers about their daily life, work, beliefs and why they live in a monastery.
Geography  Trees and Forests Natural Resources	Choose a tree near your home. Sketch it and record its approximate height, leaf shape, bark, fruit/seeds and location.	Collect or photograph different leaves. Sort them into groups according to shape, size, colour or type. Create a labelled leaf collection.	Plant a seed and keep a growth diary for 2–3 weeks. Record measurements, make observations and draw what changes.	Investigate how much water your household uses in one day. Record ways water is used and make posters for your home for how you can save water.	Create a poster showing what people can get from forests; including wood, paper, food, medicines and habitats.	Count how many items your household throws away or recycles in one day. Draw a bar chart or a pictogram to show your results.
